

Read Before Applying to this Organization

When applying to this organization you are taking on a huge commitment. We are not only committed to providing for the visitors and citizens in our responding area but, we are also committed to our fire department.

If you get voted into this department as a Junior or Probationary Firefighter, you will be expected to be dedicated to this department. Listed below is a preview of the certain tasks you will be expected to do:

- Attend training drills which are conducted on every Tuesday of the month, except for the first Tuesday of the month which is when we hold our regular monthly meeting. You are also expected to attend each regular monthly meeting as well.
- Attend fundraisers which usually occur on the 3rd Saturday of every month. This ranges from the Chicken BBQs to Breakfast Buffets. Both of these events require help starting as early as 5am and can end as late as 2pm. We also have dinners that start at 3pm and can end as late as 10pm.
- Attend other various fundraisers we have such as operating our food booth during the Page Valley Fair and the Page Valley Heritage Festival. As well as our Truck & Tractor Pull and our Golf Tournament. These 4 events bring in a lot of revenue for the department and everyone's help is needed.
- Attend our annual fund drive which occurs during one week of October (National Fire Prevention Week). This will consist of you going door to door asking the citizens of our responding area to make a donation to our department.
- Participate in cleaning of the fire department. This is not just an individual effort but you are also expected to clean up things on your own.
- Also, as your time as a Junior or Probationary Firefighter you should attempt to get training that is beneficial to the department. This could be Firefighter I & II or any other fire related training. Any fire officer can be asked about this training.
- Lastly, respond to as many emergency and public service calls as possible. Being present for calls is where you, as a Junior or Probationary Firefighter, can learn and become an educated firefighter and an important part to this organization.

All of these above bullets describes what is expected and needed of you when you are a Junior or Probationary Firefighter. You should try to attend every single one of these various events. If you cannot attend, you need to make an Officer of this department aware.

Dedication, from you, to the department is what will allow us to keep operating day to day as a 100% volunteer organization. It will also show that you want to be part of this department and want to contribute to it. Something to think about is, "What can I do for the department?" Not "what can the department do for me?"
